HOW DO I GET MY GED SCORES?

Your GED answer sheets are scanned to the Oklahoma Scoring Service after each test session. You should be able to get your GED test score within 24 hours. The exception will be the Writing Test which will take about 3 days.

Go to the online website: <https://secure.gedwizard.com> (Note the “s” in “https”.)

On the Login page, it asks, “Do you know your GED Wizard Account’s email and password?”
Fill in your email and password on the LEFT side under “Yes, I do!”

Choose one of the following:

_____ If you registered online, use the email and password that you created at Registration.

**** If you lost the login information, you cannot call or email to get it. Instead, you must come to the Testing Center in person with proper ID to receive login information.**

_____ If you registered by filling out your demographic information in a paper booklet, the Wizard computer program has created your email and password for you.

Your username (email address) is: (your first name).(your last name).(your SS#)@mi.non

Example: If your name is John Smith and your Social Security number is 123456789,
then your email address would be: john.smith.123456789@mi.non

Your password is: abc(your social security number). Example: abc123456789

****The Holland GED Testing Center will send you an Official Transcript of your GED scores after you have passed all five of the GED tests successfully. The Michigan State Department of Education will send your GED certificate.**

****Be sure to update The Testing Center with any address changes and/or telephone number changes that occur during your testing process to ensure that you get your GED documents.**

****REMEMBER that each GED test must have a minimum score of 410. If not, that test must be re-taken in order to receive a GED certificate. Each of the GED tests may be taken a maximum of three times per calendar year, if necessary. An average of 450 for all five tests (which is a total of 2250 points) must be obtained to receive a GED certificate. If you obtain a minimum score of 410 on a GED test, then extra points from another test may be used to reach the 450 average.**
