GED TESTING GUIDELINES

All tests may be taken in English or Spanish.
 GED certification requires successful completion of EACH of the 5 GED Tests.
 Cost is \$30 per test or total amount of \$150.

WRITING TEST (120 min.)	Part 1 – 50 questions Part 2 – Write an essay	READING TEST	40 questions (65 min.)

SCHEDULE A TEST: MUST BE DONE AT LEAST 2 HOURS before a test session.

- Call the Testing Center 616-355-1808 to make an appointment for a test session.
- **NO WALK-IN TESTING.**

TEST DAY

- **ARRIVE** at Room 213 at least 15 minutes before your test time to allow ample time for check-in.
- **BRING PAYMENT** to the test session.
 \$30 in cash, check, or voucher (non-expired) will be accepted.
 Your test **CANNOT** be sent in for scoring without payment.
- **SHOW VALID PHOTO ID** at EVERY test session.
 A current driver’s license, a Michigan ID card, or a passport are the best choices.
- **DO NOT BRING CELL PHONES.**
 Any phone interruptions during a test session may result in termination of your test.
 If you bring a cell phone, it must be **COMPLETELY** turned off during the test session.
- **DO NOT EXPECT TO LEAVE THE ROOM DURING YOUR TEST SESSION.**
 Restroom facilities are available for use **BEFORE** the test session.
