The occupancy of the in-person meetings is established for the Holland Public Schools Board Training Room by sitting in the chairs clearly marked with an X on the floor. No standing in or around the perimeter of the room will be allowed. Individuals are encouraged to attend in an on-line format for full participation. The maximum occupancy for this room has been established at 21 inclusive of the BOE and District Administration.
