Additionally, members of the public may both attend meetings and participate in public comment in person to the extent permitted under the OMA and following the requirements issued by the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services. Overall attendance at any public meeting must not exceed 50% of the total occupancy limits established by the fire marshal. Attendees should avoid intermingling with people outside of their group and each group must remain six feet apart. All applicable masking and distancing requirements must be followed by everyone at all times. The occupancy of the in-person meetings is established for the Holland Public Schools Board Training Room by sitting in the chairs clearly marked with an X on the floor. No standing in or around the perimeter of the room will be allowed. Individuals are encouraged to attend in an on-line format for full participation. The maximum occupancy for this room has been established at 21 inclusive of the BOE and District Administration.
