| 1960s       | Liberal           | Late 1990s  | Less liberal      |
| Early 1970s | Less liberal      | Early 2000s | Conservative      |
| Early 1980s | Conservative      | Late 2000s  | Less conservative |

See a pattern here? These are all general in terms and scope, but they are fairly accurate. Why does this pattern emerge? Today, you will analyze the cause and effect of the rise of the Moral Majority. You will note how the coming of this organization coincided with one of these periods of time.

- 7) Include a conclusion that suggests that the resurgence of the Moral Majority is ideal or not ideal for contemporary America, based on your research.
