## **GLOSSARY AND CREDITS**

One of the most widely used (12 million tons annually) organic chemicals in industry is ethylene (ethene),  $C_2H_4$ , which is manufactured from ethane,  $C_2H_6$ , obtained from petroleum. Ethylene is formed according to the dehydrogenation reaction given by the equation:

 $C_2H_6 \rightarrow C_2H_4 + H_2$
